Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2025

I. Executive Summary

Reporting Period: October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025

The Department of War (DoW) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) program received 77,423 requests and processed 70,441 requests for records under the FOIA in fiscal year (FY) 2025. The DoW released information in 47% of all processed cases and released information in 91% of cases in which documents were located. The DoW completed 83% of its requests in FY 2025 in fewer than 100 days. Requests were granted in full for 32% of those requests; a partial release of documents was made in 58% of those requests; and 10% of requests were denied in full based on FOIA exemptions. The privacy exemptions, Exemptions 6 and 7(C), were the most common exemptions, accounting for approximately 66% of all exemptions used.

The number of pending FOIA requests for the DoW at the end of FY 2025 was 40,606, an approximate 20% increase from the 33,852 requests pending at the end of FY 2024. The number of backlogged requests (those still open past the statutory response time) increased from 21,436 at the end of FY 2024 to 30,476 at the end of FY 2025, an approximate 42% increase in backlogged requests. The number of backlogged appeals increased from 607 to 692, a 14% increase in FY 2025. The number of pending consultations decreased from 1,357 to 1,348, a 7% decrease in FY 2025.

B. Definitions of Terms

- **Administrative Appeal:** A request to a federal agency asking that it review, at a higher administrative level, a FOIA determination made by the agency at the initial request level.
- **Average Number:** The number obtained by dividing the sum of a group of numbers by the quantity of numbers in the group. For example: the average of 3, 7, and 14 is 8.
- **Backlog:** The number of requests or administrative appeals that are pending at an agency at the end of the fiscal year that are beyond the statutory time period for a response.
- **Component:** DoW processes requests on a decentralized basis; a “component” is an entity, also sometimes referred to as an Office, Combatant Command, or Departmental Agency, within DoW that processes FOIA requests.
- **Consultation:** The procedure whereby an agency responding to a FOIA request first forwards a record to another agency for its review because that other agency has an interest in the document. Once the agency in receipt of the consultation finishes its review of the record, it responds back to the agency that forwarded it. That agency, in turn, will then respond to the FOIA requester. The DoW tracked consultations as FOIA requests until July 1, 2008. Due to Department of Justice (DOJ) guidance, they are now tracked and reported separately.
- **Exemption 3 Statute:** A federal statute that exempts information from disclosure and

which the agency relies on to withhold information under subsection (b)(3) of the FOIA.

- **FOIA Request:** A FOIA request is generally a request to an agency for access to records concerning another person (i.e., a “third-party” request), or concerning an organization, or a particular topic of interest. FOIA requests also include requests made by requesters seeking records concerning themselves (i.e., “first-party” requests) when those requesters are not subject to the Privacy Act, such as non-U.S. citizens. Moreover, because all first-party requesters should be afforded the benefit of both the access provisions of the FOIA as well as those of the Privacy Act, FOIA requests also include any first-party requests where an agency determines that it must search beyond its Privacy Act “systems of records” or where a Privacy Act exemption applies and the agency then applies the FOIA to afford the individual the greatest possible access. All requests which require the agency to use the FOIA in responding to the requester are included in this report.
- **Full Grant:** An agency decision to disclose all records in full in response to a FOIA request.
- **Full Denial:** An agency decision not to release any records in response to a FOIA request because the records are exempt in their entireties under one or more of the FOIA exemptions, or because of a procedural reason, such as when no records could be located.
- **Median Number:** The middle, not average, number. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the median number is 7.
- **Multi-Track Processing:** A system in which simple requests requiring relatively minimal review are placed in one processing track and more voluminous and complex requests are placed in one or more other tracks. Requests granted expedited processing are placed in yet another track. Requests in each track are processed on a first in/first out basis (see below).
 - **Expedited Processing** – an agency will process a FOIA request on an expedited basis when a requester satisfies the requirements for expedited processing as set forth in the statute and agency regulations.
 - **Simple Request** – a FOIA request that an agency using multi-track processing places in its fastest (non-expedited) track based on the low volume and/or simplicity of the records requested.
 - **Complex Request** – a FOIA request that an agency using multi-track processing places in a slower track based on the high volume and/or complexity of the records requested.
- **Partial Grant/Partial Denial:** An agency decision to disclose portions of the records and to withhold other portions that are exempt under the FOIA, or to otherwise deny a portion of the request for a procedural reason.
- **Pending Request or Pending Administrative Appeal:** A request or administrative appeal for which an agency has not taken final action in all respects.
- **Perfect Request:** A request for records which reasonably describes such records and

is made in accordance with agency regulations stating the time, place, fees (if any), and procedures to be followed.

- **Processed Request or Processed Administrative Appeal:** A request or administrative appeal for which an agency has taken final action in all respects.
- **Range in Number of Days:** The lowest and highest number of days to process requests or administrative appeals.
- **Time Limits:** The time period in the FOIA for an agency to respond to a FOIA request (ordinarily 20 working days from proper receipt of a “perfected” FOIA request).

C. FOIA Exemptions and Definitions

- **Exemption 1:** Classified national defense and foreign relations information.
- **Exemption 2:** Information that is related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency.
- **Exemption 3:** Information that is prohibited from disclosure by another federal law.
- **Exemption 4:** Trade secrets and other confidential business information.
- **Exemption 5:** Inter-agency or intra-agency communications that are protected by legal privileges.
- **Exemption 6:** Information involving matters of personal privacy.
- **Exemption 7:** Records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, to the extent that the production of those records that:
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings,
 - (B) would deprive a person of the right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication,
 - (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,
 - (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source,
 - (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or
 - (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual.
- **Exemption 8:** Information relating to the supervision of financial institutions.
- **Exemption 9:** Geological information concerning wells.
